





Our Day of Recollection on 1 May 2019 will be conducted by a team from The Institute for World Evangelisation - ICPE Mission. It is an International Association of Christ's faithful of Pontifical Right and is the missionary arm of the Glory of God International Covenant Community, which started out in Malta.

Today, ICPE Missionary Communities and/or ICPE Communities of Companions are spread around the world. With the blessing of Archbishop Emeritus Nicholas Chia, ICPE Mission Singapore began in 2003.

In 2014, 11 brothers and sisters took their covenant to form the first Community of Companions of the ICPE Mission in Singapore. These are covenanted members whose personal vocation places them at the heart of society, living the ICPE charism and spirituality at the workplace, in the family and in the Church, wherever these members live. The ICPE Mission Singapore also ministers through hosting retreats, talks & sessions, facilitating pastoral leadership, evangelisation and creativity workshops and assisting in conferences.

Procession of the Blessed Sacrament after Evening Mass




Week of Guided Prayer (21 to 28 July)

Listen to the Lord as He speaks to us through Scripture. Learn how to pray using Scripture with the help of a Prayer Guide. Conducted by Sojourners' Companions, the programme consists of a training on 21st July afternoon, half-hour prayer at home & half hour with Prayer Guide at our parish on Monday to Friday (anytime from 9am-10pm) and closing on 28th July.

"A Biblical Walk Through The Mass" - A 5-weekly bible study of the Sacred Liturgy, it explores the biblical roots of the words and gestures we experience in the Liturgy and explains their profound significance. This intriguing look at the Mass guides us to embrace it as the best way to grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ. Conducted by our Bible Apostolate Team and commencing in July/August.

Christian Meditation (16, 23, 30 Aug & 4 Sep) - Conducted by the World Community for Christian Meditation (WCCM) at our parish, these 4 one-hourly sessions help us to grow in holiness by giving a contemplative dimension to our faith. The silence, stillness and simplicity will lead to the surrender of the self. Amidst all the noise, distraction and busyness of our daily lives, we are in urgent need to be rooted in the centre of our being where the Spirit of God dwells. Parish Day of Corporal Works of Mercy (14 Sept)



Day 1: The Beatitudes : our roadmap to holiness

Day 2 :Being poor of heart: that is holiness

Day 3: Reacting with meekness and humility: that is holiness

Day 4: Knowing how to mourn with others: that is holiness.

Day 5: Hungering and thirsting for righteousness: that is holiness

Day 6: Seeing and acting with mercy: that is holiness

Day 7: Keeping a heart free of all that tarnishes love: that is holiness

Day 8: Sowing peace all around us: that is holiness

Day 9: Accepting daily the path of the Gospel: that is holiness
